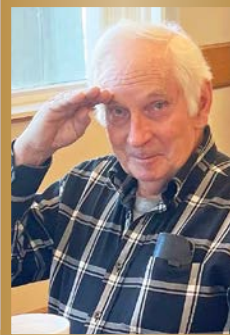
## *Thankful for All Our Blessings*
